## SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

### Protecting Yourself from Scholarship Scams

**This advice can help you avoid becoming the victim of a scholarship scam.**

1. If you must pay money to get money, it might be a scam.
2. If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.
3. Spend the time, not the money.
4. Never invest more than a postage stamp to get information about scholarships.
5. Legitimate scholarship foundations do not charge application fees.
6. If you're suspicious of an offer, it's usually with good reason. Don't be fooled by an official sounding name. Words like "National," "Foundations," or "Administration" in the title doesn't mean it is a legitimate operation.

Scholarship recipients are selected by a panel of Illinois agriculture agency representatives. Winners are notified in writing by the Treasurer's Office prior to May 30, 2008 and honored at the Illinois State Fair. Scholarship funds are restricted to the payment of tuition, books and/or room and board at the educational institution. **The deadline is May 15, 2008.**

### **WOMEN'S CLUB OF ADDISON SCHOLARSHIP**

The Women's Club of Addison will award two graduating females from either Addison Trail and/or Driscoll Catholic High School a \$1000 scholarship for the 2008-2009 academic year. Applications are available in the Guidance Office. **The deadline is April 3, 2008.**

### DUPAGE COUNTY FARM BUREAU FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The DuPage County Farm Bureau Foundation is offering up to (4) \$1000 scholarships to qualified students. Students' parents must be members in good standing of the DuPage County Farm Bureau for at least two years prior to January, 2008 and be planning a career in chemical/biological research, association management, agricultural engineering, law, accounting, communications, economics or another agricultural occupation.
