

# WHO'S WHO IN AMERICAN PSYCHOLOGY

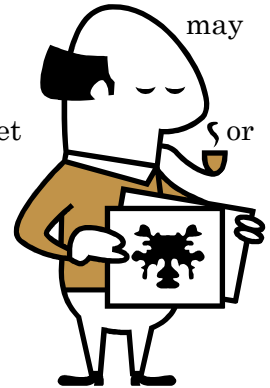
## Purpose:

The purpose of this assignment is to learn about some of the most influential people in psychology. You will need to research your selected psychologist and design an informative poster.

## Requirements:

1. Use ½ a sheet of poster board (a full sheet may be used if necessary) \*\*\*you want to bring this to class tomorrow

2. Include a **CLEAR** picture of your psychologist. This may be from the Internet copied from a book. If you are feeling especially creative and are interested in earning a few bonus points you may decide to draw a caricature of your psychologist which would incorporate the major bullet points. For example, if Thomas Jefferson were a psychologist you may draw him within his home state of Virginia holding a copy of the Declaration of Independence and plans for UVA while wearing a presidential t-shirt.



3. Write a bulleted explanation of your person (**no more than 5 bullets**)

Include:

- a. What he/she did to shape psychology – major contributions and or experiments. Note there may be more than one item.
- b. Years they completed their work.
- c. Other cool facts (nicknames, awards, background, things you found interesting)

4. Present your poster and explain the importance of your person.

All posters must be written clearly in black permanent marker or typed and attached to poster.
