Building The Future Construction on Schedule for Opening of School on September 7

During the Board of Education meeting, the District 88 community honored a moment of silence for former Willowbrook High School teacher and coach John Hamann. He started teaching Industrial Technology in 1966. In addition, he coached the Warrior Basketball team from 1966-1985 and the golf team from 1970 until his retirement in 2000.

BUILDING THE FUTURE IN DISTRICT 88:

Jeannine Eicker, of Bovis Lend Lease construction management, reviewed the impact of the construction strike from July 1-13 during which time nine workdays were lost. Construction resumed on July 14 and is on schedule for the Regional Office of Education Occupancy inspection scheduled for September 2. Jeannine highlighted the work to be completed by August 2010 and other deferred projects that will continue into Fall 2010. Interior and exterior photos showed the progress of summer projects including science labs, main entrance canopy, practice fields and stadium track expansion.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

- Educational Focus items will be presented at the next board meeting on August 30, 2010. The items will include a summer school report, successes from the 2009-2010 school year and Prairie State Achievement Exam/Adequate Yearly Progress results.
- A Freedom of Information request was received from Mr. Dan O'Brien from Illinois Central School Bus. The requested information has been forwarded to Mr. O'Brien.
- In September, the Board of Education will complete the **District 88 Vision Project** by reviewing community input from three feedback sessions facilitated in the spring of 2010 by a national consultant. The final statements will become the vision and direction for District 88.
- The purpose of the Federal Education Jobs Bill is to appropriate \$26 billion to return staff to school buildings in an effort to reduce the nationwide impact of teaching staff reductions. Illinois is slated to receive \$415 million with District 88 receiving approximately \$206,000 under the current distribution system based on General State Aid allocation. This amount would be in addition to the current state dollars projected in the 2010-2011 budget. Once received, the recommendation is to fund additional sections reduced last spring as part of cost containment. Final section recommendations will be presented at the September 20 Board meeting.
- **Revised Board Policy 8:20 Community Use of School Facilities** was reviewed and will be approved at a future date once final discussions and revisions are completed.

SCHOOL RECOGNITION:

Addison Trail Assistant Principal Mr. Adam Cibulka highlighted recent events:

- The Freshman Orientation Program was held with the support of the F.A.S.T. (Freshmen Are Students Too) leaders. Approximately 85% of freshman students were in attendance.
- Over 250 students participated in summer school and earned credits for the 2010-2011 school year.
- Upcoming events include: First Day of School, Open House and a special performance by the Jersey Boys cast.

Willowbrook Assistant Principal Mrs. Ann Kimpton highlighted recent events:

- Willowbrook has partnered with Salt Creek School District 48 to conduct CRISS staff development training for their staff this school year, which will help to build awareness of instructional practices and common language.
- Over 600 student athletes participated in the Code of Conduct meeting for Fall sports and activities.
- Upcoming events include: First Day of School, Open House, and Homecoming.
