DISCUSSED FOR FUTURE ACTION:

Recommendation of "Directions" Alternative School designed to assist freshman and sophomore students succeed. This cooperative program with Downers Grove High School District 99, Glenbard High School District 87 and DuPage High School District 88 will be operational by January 2008. Current staffing needs are based on 80 students with enrollment allocations based on the district populations.

Developed around the focus of **providing behavior and academic support for student success**, "Directions" will be **housed at the Technology Center of DuPage** located at 301 S. Swift Road in Addison. The DuPage County Regional Office of Education has been a supporting partner in helping launch this learning program.
