Credit Card Summary

Chief Financial Officer Mr. Edward Hoster reviewed the district's credit card use report for April 2017, as outlined in Board Policy 4:55 Use of Credit and Procurement Cards.

Workers Compensation Insurance Renewal 2017-18

Mr. Hoster reported the district is a member of the School Employees Loss Fund (SELF), which is a cooperative of 80 school districts in Illinois that self-insure for workers compensation insurance. Our annual premium reflects a 12.4% increase over the prior year. The renewal for 2017-18 reflects a lower surplus return that was not enough to offset our increasing loss ratio due to claims. The district continues to work closely with the Loss Prevention team at SELF to conduct staff training and participate in loss prevention annually.

Sprint Grant Hotspot Donation

Director of Technology, Teaching & Learning Dr. Aaron Lenaghan updated the Board on a grant opportunity through SPRINT. This grant is specific to hotspots for students who do not have an Internet connection outside of school, allowing them access to technology resources in terms of curriculum and academic areas outside of the school day. The district would receive 300 hotspots per year over the next five years for a total of a \$150,000 grant. SPRINT not only is giving us the devices, but also the monthly data plan that includes a 4G connection. These devices will be filtered (no inappropriate materials) and capped (prevention of overage). The students would be eligible for a discounted plan after they graduate.
