# Board Honors "88's Best" for May

The Board of Education recognizes students who excel at Addison Trail and Willowbrook High Schools through **88's Best**. They were pleased to honor the following students for their academic achievements:

**Justin Cruce** has pushed himself to be one of the top academic performers at **Addison Trail.** He ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in his class of 481 seniors, has been named a member of the Distinct Honor Roll for all four years and is a 2-year member of the National Honor Society.
