# District 88 Names Principal for Addison Trail for 2012-13 School Year

During the DuPage High School District 88 Board of Education meeting on August 15, board members voted unanimously to approve **Mr. Adam Cibulka** as the Principal of Addison Trail High School, effective the 2012-13 school year.

He will officially begin his duties as the 8<sup>th</sup> Principal in the high school's history on July 1, 2012. Cibulka will replace Dr. Scott Helton following his transition to the Superintendent of Schools. Helton will replace Dr. Steve Humphrey who concludes 12 years of service in District 88 and 42 years in education on June 30, 2012.

A member of the District 88 school community since 2004, Cibulka has experience as a classroom teacher, department chairman, teacher mentor, sponsor and coach. He became Assistant Principal of Addison Trail High School in July 2008. He will concurrently serve in this role for the new school year and begin transitional duties related to the Principal's position.





#### **DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD:**

Mrs. Donna Craft Cain, President of the Board of Education, honored Mary Lou Costabile for her Distinguished Service to District 88.

An ATHS alumna, her personal and parent involvement at Addison Trail spans decades of meetings, volunteer commitments, concession stand sales, and organizing several *Jersey Boys* concerts.
