Advanced Placement Preparation Summer Program

- Program meets once a week for 3 hours for 5 weeks over summer.
- Designed for students interested in taking AP coursework during their high school career.
 - o Content focuses on Social Studies, but skills emphasized will prove beneficial for all AP courses.
- Explanation of Advanced Placement Program and the tests that are given every May.
- Students gain understanding of expectations of AP coursework.
- Students gain an understanding of the pace and the complexity that makes AP classes different.
- Students get feedback on the AP coursework they are producing in the course.
- Weekly homework assignment and exam at end of course to help students understand what they will be exposed to on a regular basis.
- Focus on development of skills that have proven critical for AP success including:
 - o Reading skills (some students going from 8th grade books to college level reading in 1 year)
 - Writing skills (writing skills developed for Social Studies very different than those used in English)
 - o Verbal skills and listening skills
 - Classroom participation stressed
 - Students will work independently and in a group dynamic
 - Time management
 - Test preparation and test taking skills
