## **Coca-Cola Scholarship**

Requirements: Must apply online at [www.coca-colascholars.org](http://www.coca-colascholars.org). This is a national scholarship (250 scholarships from \$10,000- \$20,000) given to well-rounded seniors. This is not a need-based scholarship, anyone can apply.

Deadline: October 31<sup>st</sup>

## **Burger King Scholars**

Requirements: Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, work a part-time job (at least 15 hours a week), demonstrate participation in community service, demonstrate financial need, and be attending a 2 year, 4 year or vocational school in the fall.

Deadline: February 15<sup>th</sup>

## **U.S. Bank Internet Scholarship Program**

Requirements: 30 \$1,000 scholarships to high school seniors attending a 2 or 4 year college.

Deadline: February of 2008

## **AXA Achievement Community Scholarship**

Requirements: (\$2000 scholarships), senior status, demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, community or workplace.

Deadline: February 15<sup>th</sup>

Requirements: Senior, entering the field of education

Requirements: ?

### **Illinois AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary Scholarship**

Requirements: Must be a child or grandchild of a US Veteran and was honorably discharged or who is presently serving in the military.

Deadline: March 1<sup>st</sup>

### **The Secretarial Scholarship in honor of Kathryn G. Hansen**

Requirements: Must be a senior pursuing higher education in an office professional, secretarial or business-related field within the State of Illinois.

Deadline: Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>

### **Rotary District 6440 Vocational Scholarship**

Requirements: Must be a senior going into a vocational area that requires less than a four year degree.

Deadline: February 5<sup>th</sup>

### **The Junior League of Kane and DuPage Counties**

Requirements: (2 \$1000 scholarships) must be a female, senior student who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to voluntarism.

Deadline: March 17<sup>th</sup>

### **Local Ronald McDonald Charities Scholarships**

Requirements: Must be a senior, see the other qualifications in the guidance office.

Deadline: February 15<sup>th</sup>

### **Phi Delta Kappa's Scholarship**

Requirements: Must be a senior, in the top one-third of your class and planning on pursuing a career as a teacher.

Deadline: February 1<sup>st</sup>

### **The Chicago Roofing Contractors Association**

Requirements: (1 \$3000 scholarship) to one high school senior who wants to pursue a field of study in: liberal arts and sciences, engineering, architecture or business.

Deadline: March 7<sup>th</sup>

### **West Suburban Teachers Union, Local 571**

Requirements: Senior students whose parent is a member of Local 571. Mary Wheeler Scholarship, Robert G. Porter Scholars Grant, Jo Ann Horowitz scholarship are a few of the available scholarships.

### **Illinois General Assembly Scholarship**

Requirements: Senior students that reside in the 46<sup>th</sup> district (Dennis Reboletti) and plan on attending a state university. This scholarship covers the student's tuition only.

Deadline: April 14<sup>th</sup>

### **The Faithful Circle Quilters Guild**

Requirements: Senior students working in, or interested in, textile art (1 \$1000 scholarship).

Deadline: April 1<sup>st</sup>

### **The General Federation of Women's Clubs (Lombard Junior Women's Club)**

Requirements: Senior students planning to study art or performing arts or majoring in the field of Library Science. Also, one vocational scholarship is also available.

Deadline: Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>

### **Plumbers and Pipe-fitters Apprentice Program**

Requirements: Senior students interested in this field of study. See Guidance Office for more details.

Deadline: Between Jan. 21<sup>st</sup> –28<sup>th</sup>

### **Hispanic Heritage Youth Award**

Requirements: Senior status, 3.0 GPA (or higher), of Hispanic/ Latino decent, check [www.hispanicheritage.org](http://www.hispanicheritage.org)

Deadline: ?

### **Rotary District 6440 Vocational Scholarship**

Requirements: Must be going into a vocational area that requires less than a 4 year degree.

Deadline: Return application by February 5<sup>th</sup> (Interviews take place the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>)

### **Omega Psi Phi Fraternity**

Requirements: African American senior who will be attending a 4 year college and has a C+ or better grade point average, see the guidance office for more details.

Deadline: ?

### **General Assembly Scholarship (State Rep. Sandra Pihos, 42<sup>nd</sup> District)**

Requirements: Senior living in the 42<sup>nd</sup> district and attending a state college or university.

Deadline: April 25<sup>th</sup>

### **The Tri-town YMCA (Gernon and Jane Henderson Scholarship)**

Requirements: Senior student who possesses the qualities of community involvement, a willingness to help others and a positive attitude toward life.

Deadline: March 26<sup>th</sup>

### **State Senator Carole A. Pankau Scholarship**

Requirements: Senior student attending a state college or university and living in the 23<sup>rd</sup> district.

Deadline: April 15<sup>th</sup>

### **College of Dupage Scholarship (Academic Excellence Scholarship)**

Requirements: Attending College of DuPage in the fall, has an unweighted GPA of 3.5 or higher or an ACT composite score of a 25 or higher.

Deadline: April 24<sup>th</sup>

### **Paramount Tall Club Scholarship**

Requirements: Senior students that fulfill the height requirements; Females 5'10 or taller, Males 6'2 or taller

Deadline: Feb. 29<sup>th</sup>

### **Joint Civic Committee of Italian Americans (3 separate scholarships)**

Requirements: (1) Female student with a 3.75 GPA or higher, one parent must be at least 25% Italian. (2) The John Fischetti scholarship is available to a male or female student who will major in journalism or media communication. (3) Male student with a 3.75 GPA or higher, one parent must be at least 25% Italian.

Deadline: (1) March 1<sup>st</sup> (2) April 10<sup>th</sup> (3) May 15<sup>th</sup>

### **Orv Wilkin Scholarship**

Requirements: 2 \$1000 scholarships, senior status and attending a 2 or 4 year college. Must have demonstrated the following qualities and characteristics; optimistic outlook on life, involvement in extra-curricular activities, showing respect for their peers and adults and serving as a friend to those in need

Deadline: April 11<sup>th</sup>

### **AHEPA's 13<sup>th</sup> District Scholarship**

Requirements: Senior status, of Greek heritage or have a parent that is an active member of the AHEPA family.

Deadline: March 18<sup>th</sup>

### **The DuPage County Chiefs of Police Association Joseph Buenrostro Scholarship**

Requirements: 1 \$1000 scholarship to any senior pursuing studies in Criminal Justice related fields.

Deadline: May 9<sup>th</sup>

### **Glen Oaks Hospital Foundation**

Requirements: 1 \$2000 scholarship to a student planning education or training in the health care related field of service.

Deadline: April 18<sup>th</sup>

### **The Lombard Chamber of Commerce**

Requirements: Senior students who reside or work for a Lombard Chamber business.

Deadline: April 3<sup>rd</sup>

### **The Community Woman's Club of Villa Park**

Requirements: Willowbrook seniors who plan on attending college or vocational school next fall and live in Villa Park. Financial need is considered.

Deadline: March 7<sup>th</sup>

### **The Rotary Club of Lombard**

Requirements: Graduating seniors living in Lombard. Completing this application enters you for a number of awards (see the guidance office for more details).

Deadline: March 18<sup>th</sup>

### **The Illinois Sheriffs Association**

Requirements: Awarding 105 scholarships to seniors wishing to pursue a higher education.

Deadline: March 14<sup>th</sup>

### **The Rotary District 6440 Vocational Scholarship**

Requirements: Senior students preparing for careers that require less than a four year degree.

Deadline: Feb. 20<sup>th</sup>

### **The Paul D. Pierotti Memorial Scholarship**

Requirements: Senior students who plan to work toward careers in natural resource management or other environmentally related fields of study. You must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.

Deadline: March 1<sup>st</sup>

### **The Carol Drennan Memorial Scholarship**

Requirements: 2 (\$1000 scholarships) to graduating seniors who are in good standing and are members of the Honorary Thespian Troop #94 (see the Guidance Office for more specific details).

Deadline: April 14<sup>th</sup>

### **The Kiwanis of Lombard**

Requirements: demonstrate exemplary efforts and achievements in scholastics, extracurricular activities and service to others. Must be a resident of the Lombard.

Deadline: March 24<sup>th</sup>

### **The Villa Park Junior Women's Club**

Requirements: (\$1000 scholarship) female student living in Villa Park with atleast a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

Deadline: April 1<sup>st</sup>

### **The Villa Park Chamber of Commerce**

Requirements: (\$1,000 scholarship) senior student pursuing a career that requires less than a four-year degree (vocational training). (2 \$1,000 scholarships) seniors attending a four-year college or university, you must be ranked in the upper 50% of your class. You must also reside in Villa Park.

### **The Marianjoy (Bruce A Schurman) Scholarship**

Requirements: Seniors students with physical disabilities

Deadline: April 21<sup>st</sup>

### **The West Suburban Chiefs of Police Association**

Requirements: (1 \$1000 scholarship) Senior student planning to attend college and pursue a degree in Criminal Justice.

Deadline: April 25<sup>th</sup>

### **The DuPage Medical Society Foundation**

Requirements: Senior student entering professional education or training in health fields directly after high school.

Deadline: April 30<sup>th</sup>

### **The Lombard Garden Club**

Requirements: One \$1,000 Scholarship to a Lombard resident who will be pursuing a major related to Horticulture, plant biology.

Deadline: April 25<sup>th</sup>

### **The Elmhurst Evening Lions Club**

Requirements: Senior that resides in Elmhurst, ranking in the top 50% of their class. Special consideration for students that can show evidence of community service and have demonstrated the ability to overcome personal obstacles.

Deadline: April 15<sup>th</sup>

### **The Nordstrom Scholarship**

Requirements: 5 \$10,000 scholarships to students in the Chicago area that have maintained a 2.7 GPA or higher and can show financial need for a scholarship.

Deadline: May 31<sup>st</sup>

### **The College of Dupage**

Requirements: COD Fall Semester Scholarship applications are now available online. There are more than 40 scholarship opportunities (examples: photography, criminal justice, and theatre to name a few).

Requirements: See the application in the Guidance Office.

### **The DuPage Juvenile Officer's Association**

Requirements: (2 \$1,000 Scholarships) Must be entering the field of law enforcement or youth social services.

Deadline: April 9<sup>th</sup>

### **The 2008 Villa Park Character Coalition College Scholarship**

Requirements: (1 \$1000 scholarship) Must be a senior that demonstrates the qualities that support the Character Coalition's mission, "*Encourage Positive Actions and Attitudes for a Healthy Community.*"

Deadline: May 2<sup>nd</sup>

### **State Senator Dan Cronin of the 21<sup>st</sup> Legislative District**

Requirements: A one-year scholarship including tuition and some fees to students who will be attending an Illinois state university/college. You must live in the 21<sup>st</sup> District.

Deadline: April 30<sup>th</sup>

### **State Representative Bob Biggins of the 41<sup>st</sup> District**

Requirements: A tuition free scholarship to a senior student seeking to continue their education at an Illinois state university/college. You must live in the 41<sup>st</sup> District.

Deadline: April 14<sup>th</sup>

**Dupage District 88 Council of Local Teachers Union (John Zgoda)**

Requirements: (2 \$500 scholarships) Senior status and must be a son or daughter of a District 88 teachers union member. Return completed applications for Mr. Drennan in the guidance office.
