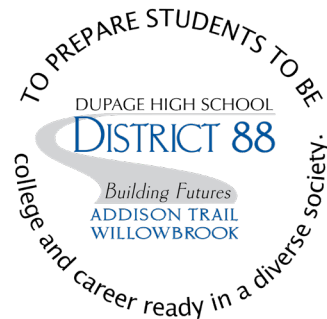

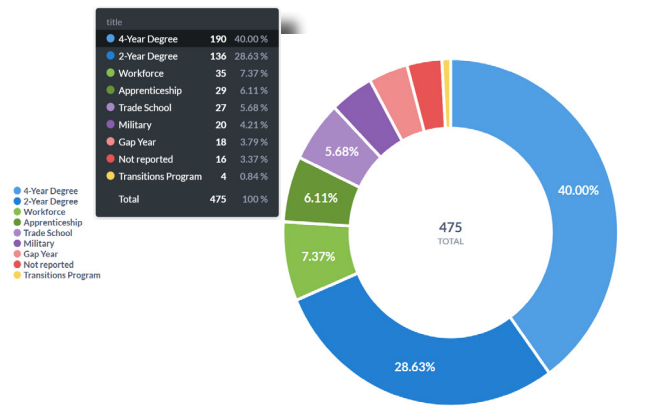

District 88's graduation rates consistently remain above the state level, and students attend top schools throughout the U.S.

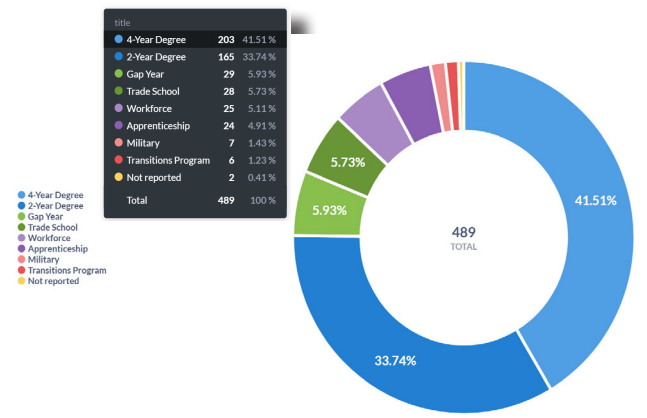

- District 88's 4-year, 5-year and 6-year **graduation rates are above 90 percent** and remain above the state level.
- District 88's 9th Grade on Track number, the **percentage of freshmen on track to graduate, is above 90 percent** and remains above the state level.
- During the 2025-26 school year, **students earned more than 6,400 college credits** through College Board's Advanced Placement (AP), Project Lead The Way, College of DuPage, Technology Center of DuPage, Elmhurst University and Dominican University. These courses allow students to earn college credit while in high school, **giving them a potential opportunity to save more than \$2.6 million in college tuition.**
- During the 2025-26 school year, **students earned more than 2,000 career certifications.**

- During the 2025-26 school year, **nearly 300 students earned the State Seal of Biliteracy recognition and/or the State Commendation toward Biliteracy recognition in about 13 languages.** This recognition is given to graduating high school students who have demonstrated a high level of proficiency in English and in another language.

- **More than 60 percent** of students are involved in a sport or activity.

- District 88 has a **long history of sound fiscal management.** The district is proud to maintain a financial rating of Aa1 from Moody's, which is the second-highest rating, as well as the highest level of recognition from the Illinois State Board of Education.
