Recognition of District 88 Successes

88's Best Students

88's Best Students <u>Annalise Morrone</u> from Addison Trail and <u>Mustafa Ali</u> from Willowbrook were recognized for the month of September. The students were congratulated on their many accomplishments. The students thanked the Board, their teachers and their families for their support. As a token of their achievements, Annalise and Mustafa were given an 88's Best glass sculpture and a certificate to a local restaurant.

\Diamond Public Hearing on the Budget for 2016-17

A public hearing took place on the budget for 2016-17.

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reported the projected deficit for the tentative budget as of June was at (\$1,236,637), and the final budget reflects a deficit of (\$983,700). Mr. Hoster further gave an overview of changes in the final budget from June. Those changes include a revenue increase of \$365,624 from property taxes, state and federal programs. The expenditure budget increased by \$190,636, with final student enrollment and staffing driving most of the related changes. The final budget reflects a revenue increase of \$867,684 over the prior year budget, mostly from additional state aid. The district's expenditure plan reflects an increase of \$300,086 over the prior year budget. The funding of capital improvement projects with bond proceeds from the 2015 debt borrowing is taking the pressure off the operating funds. Significant constraint was necessary throughout the budgeting process to minimize the use of financial reserves.

Senate Bill 100

Director of Student Services Sam Bentsen presented information about Senate Bill 100, which focuses on reforming student discipline in Illinois to help ensure equality for all students. He further discussed the steps District 88 is taking to continue to meet the requirements of this bill.
