# 'Transition' Special Education Program Presented to Board

#### **INFORMATION ITEMS:**

- Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Director of Learning Services, presented an overview of the proposed Special Education 'Transition' program. The program is designed to comply with Illinois State Board of Education Special Education mandates. Special Education teachers Ann Cadagin-Smith, Kim Chao, Ann Eakley and Susan Moran detailed the components of the program and how it will safely help cognitively disabled students learn life skills, obtain employment in a community setting and transition to life after District 88. A follow-up presentation will be presented to the Board of Education.
- Mrs. Beth Yacobi, Director of Curriculum and Learning, previewed the Educational Focus items that will be presented at the next board meeting on February 25, 2008. This will include 88's Best for extra-curricular activities, summer school information and literacy interventions that have been implemented and future considerations for literacy support.
