# PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Support) Update

Mrs. Barbanente along with the PBIS Core Team, (Mr. Murphy, Mr. O'Connell, Mr. Isaacson, Ms. Courington, and Ms. Yonke), presented data on the PBIS program. Implementation began at the start of the 2007-2008 school year following training and summer meetings with faculty and staff to discuss student expectations. These expectations included goals of safety, respect, responsibility, attendance, dress code and hallway behavior.

The results show the number of unexcused absences and discipline referrals have significantly decreased since PBIS has been in place.

# ACT College Readiness Report

Mrs. Yacobi presented the ACT College Readiness reports for Addison Tail and Willowbrook. Both schools showed growth and gains in English, mathematics, reading and science. District 88 continues to align its curriculum with the ACT curriculum-based tests of educational development by providing intervention in math and literacy.
