# Course Selection Process and Summer School Offerings

Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Assistant Superintendent, and Dr. Adam Cibulka, Director of Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment, shared that during the months of January and February, the District 88 staff works with students on next year's course selection and summer school offerings to help ensure students meet the graduation requirements and college/career goals. Summer school will take place from June 4 to 29, with a focus on students earning credits to stay on track for graduation or accelerate their earning of credits. Students may also participate in an Advanced Placement (AP)/college-level prep course or in a STEM Camp. The STEM Camp also is open to students in districts 4, 45 and 48.

## Technology Delivery Model Update

Mrs. Barbanente and Dr. Aaron Lenaghan, Director of Technology, Teaching and Learning, gave an update on the implementation of the new Technology Delivery Model for fall 2018, which includes moving from mobile devices on carts to deploying a Chromebook for every incoming freshman, with an annual phase-in by class and working to control the cost for families. The administration is currently working on policy and procedures; communication to students, parents and staff; the creation of Q&A documents; continuation of staff development; reviewing of device models for durability and sustainability; and third-party



insurance vendor options. They also reported the principals gave an overview on the utilization of student Chromebooks to incoming freshmen and their parents at last week's Course Information Night/Curriculum Showcase.
