Educational Focus Item for February 26, 2018

The Educational Focus Item for the February 26 Board meeting will be the clarification of new legislation related to Physical Education requirements.

Auditor Service Selection Process

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, presented the renewal proposal from Mathieson, Moyski, Austin & Co., LLP, to complete the fiscal year 2018 audit. This represents year two of a three-year commitment, with a fee of \$28,400, which is an increase of 0.7 percent. This fee is competitive with other area schools, based on a recent survey. Hoster requested direction from the Board on whether to renew with current firm.

Transportation Contract Extension for 2018-19 Regular and Special Education Services

Mr. Hoster highlighted the transportation service performance for the past five months. A key improvement has been on-time arrival of students to school in the morning and afternoon at both schools, even though full staffing has not been achieved. Financial credits of just under \$25,000 have been applied according to the renewal contract terms. Hoster requested authority to initiate negotiations for renewal with current vendor.
