EDUCATIONAL FOCUS ITEMS:

• Mrs. Beth Yacobi, Director of Curriculum & Learning, presented information about the adoption of new textbooks for the 2009-2010 school year for both schools. The District selected ten books as part of the Illinois State Textbook Loan program and the savings from these titles will be passed along to parents. Five courses have been selected to have classroom sets of books rather than students purchasing individual books. The Board will take formal action to approve these recommendations at the May Board meeting.

• Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Director of Learning Services, presented proposed changes to the student handbook. The proposed changes focus on compliance, newly introduced technology and suggestions from internal staff.
