REGIONAL SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, DR. DARLENE RUSCITTI:

Addison Trail Principal Dr. Scott Helton highlighted recent events and recognition:

- Over 400 students were represented with families attending Open House. In addition to four Building The Future tours, parents visited classrooms, received PowerSchool training and attended Guidance presentations.
- The Guidance Department has hosted student and parent fieldtrips to Northwestern and the University of Illinois at Chicago. Future fieldtrips are scheduled in October for North Central College and Northern Illinois University.
- Upcoming events: Guidance Open House, District football game and cookout at WB, and Freshman Parent Night.

Willowbrook Principal Mr. Dan Krause also highlighted recent events and recognition:

- Over 950 students were represented with families attending Open House. The parent feedback was very positive
 and visitors enjoyed being able to visit with teachers, tour the building and receive PowerSchool training.
