Parents Alliance Employment Project

The Parents Alliance Employment Project (PAEP) awarded District 88's Transition Program with the Community Partner of the Year and Vocational Award on October 16, 2018. PAEP provides a variety of programs and services to individuals with developmental disabilities, including career counseling, job training and preparation, job development, job placement and job coaching and follow-up. Each year, PAEP recognizes a business partner or community partner with this award.

Forecast5 Analytics
