


Monday, June 11, 2018 Regular Business Board Of Education Meeting

Property/Casualty/Liability Insurance Renewal

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reported the district is a member of the Collective Liability Insurance Cooperative (CLIC), a self-funded insurance cooperative representing 181 school districts throughout Illinois. This year's annual premium reflects a 6.2-percent decrease due to the decline in our five-year loss ratio.

Intergovernmental Agreement for Point to Point Wireless Services

Mr. Hoster shared the district's legal counsel and District 45's legal counsel have prepared an Intergovernmental Agreement to provide a point to point Internet backup service to stabilize daily Internet service, if the districts experience an unexpected failure of its respective service.

Easement Request by Village of Villa Park

Mr. Hoster reported the Village of Villa Park has requested consideration of a Grant of Easement for the vacant property north of Highridge Road and south of Leslie Lane. The district owns the vacant parcel that contains a sidewalk and is not buildable. The easement would allow the village to install a storm sewer main in that area.

Review of Board Policies (1st Reading) - as reviewed by Board Policy Committee on June 6, 2018

Superintendent Dr. Scott Helton shared the Policy Committee met on June 6 to review board policies in which PRESS suggested revisions. The suggested changes were non-substantial for nine of the policies. Assistant Superintendent Mrs. Jean Barbanente shared the changes in Policy 5:125 were substantial and include language regarding the Remind app when staff members communicate remotely from personal devices with students for school-related communication.
