# Educational Focus Item for May 23, 2016

The Educational Focus Item for the May 23 Board meeting will be Staff Development for the 2016-17 school year.

#### **Donation of Laptops**

Dr. Aaron Lenaghan, Director of Technology, Teaching and Learning, shared that about 100 older-model HP 6530B laptops will be phased out of general student use at Willowbrook and Addison Trail. These refurbished laptops will be donated to area libraries. The purpose is to increase student access to technology beyond the school day and availability for extended checkout.

#### PSAT/SAT Assessment Cost Analysis

Mr. Adam Cibulka, Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, shared the PSAT/SAT Cost Analysis for the 2016-17 school year, as well as the district's timeline to administer the assessments. The CollegeBoard proposal includes all tests, student data and Advanced Placement (AP) potential. This contract will be brought to the Board for approval.

Superintendent Dr. Scott Helton informed the Board of the administration's proposal to administer the PSAT to freshmen and sophomores, provide the student data to the state and opt out of the PARCC assessment. This proposal was circulated to the superintendents in DuPage, Lake and South Cook counties, with 50-60 districts on board, and will be submitted to the State Superintendent.
