- 3. Complete the annotation handout worksheet for each chapter (copies on English website and Google Classroom)
- 4. Read and annotate the short story *The Lottery* by Shirley Jackson.
- 5. Complete the 3-2-1-1 handout
 - a. SUBMIT ALL WORK THROUGH GOOGLE CLASSROOM

All materials (annotation handout and 3-2-1-1 document) will be due Friday, August 27th.

In total, you will <u>read and annotate</u> using the handout **Lord of the Flies**, "The Lottery" by Shirley Jackson, complete <u>the 3-2-1-1</u> handout and take a novel test when back in school.
