Summer School Update

Dr. Adam Cibulka, Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, presented an overview on this year's summer school programs, which align to the district's school improvement goals. The target areas include On-Track for Graduation Programs, Credit Advancement Programs, Special Education Extended School Year (ESY) and STEM Summer Camp.

Of the 87 students who participated in the STEM Camp, 37 were District 88 students. The camp was funded through grant funds.
