Educational Focus Item for June 24, 2019

The Educational Focus Item for the June 24 Board meeting will include updates on Community Relations and Technology.

Freedom of Information Requests

The following Freedom of Information request was denied for the reason that it is unduly burdensome:

A request from Ms. Kelly Lopez, for:

- How many honors classes are offered at each school, how many AP classes are offered at each school?
- In the past 6 years, how many students Willowbrook/Addison Trail (separated by building) have taken honors classes? Of those honors students, how many switched to AP classes when available, how many switched back to core from honors?
- AP, how many students taking AP classes took the AP exam in their respective classes and scored a 4 or 5?
- How many students drop AP or honors classes after the semester starts or at the semester?
- How many students taking AP received a C or above?
- How many students who take dual-credit classes actually sign up for the credit and receive a C or above?



• How many honors students did not continue with AP English at Willowbrook when honors was no longer offered (believe 2016-17 school year)?

Property/Casualty/Liability Insurance Renewal 2019-20

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reported the district is a member of the Collective Liability Insurance Cooperative (CLIC), a self-funded insurance cooperative representing 183 school districts throughout Illinois. This year's annual premium reflects a 2.5-percent decrease due to the decline in our five-year loss ratio.

Workers Compensation Insurance Renewal 2019-20

Mr. Hoster reported the district is a member of the School Employees Loss Fund (SELF), which is a cooperative of 80 school districts in Illinois that self-insure for workers compensation insurance. Our annual premium reflects a decrease of 2.8 percent over the prior year. The district continues to work closely with the Loss Prevention team at SELF to conduct staff training and participate in loss prevention annually.

Proposed 2020-21 School Calendar

Dr. Scott Helton, Superintendent, presented a draft of the 2020-21 School Calendar and highlighted August 17, 2020, as the first day of school, and final exams will be administered before the winter break. He further explained the use of April 23, 2021, as a Non-Attendance or Emergency Day, should an inclement day be required.

DuPage West Cook Intergovernmental Agreement

Dr. Helton shared as a member of SASED (School Association for Special Education in DuPage County) District 88 also is a member of the DuPage/West Cook Regional Association (DWC). The DWC provides special education programs and services for students who are deaf/hard of hearing and blind/visually impaired. Dr. Helton proposed the ratification of the resolution approving the proposed amendments to the DuPage/West Cook Regional Special Education Association Intergovernmental Agreement.
