### Credit Card Summary

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reviewed the district's credit card use report for April 2018, as outlined in Board Policy 4:55 Use of Credit and Procurement Cards.

# Workers Compensation Insurance Renewal 2018-19

Mr. Hoster reported the district is a member of the School Employees Loss Fund (SELF), which is a cooperative of 80 school districts in Illinois that self-insure for workers compensation insurance. Our annual premium reflects a 23 percent increase from the prior year. The renewal for 2018-19 reflects a lower surplus return that was not enough to offset our premium increase, as it has the past four years. The district continues to work closely with the Loss Prevention team at SELF to conduct staff training and participate in loss prevention annually.
