# Overview of 2016-17 Financial Report (Unaudited) as of June 30, 2017

Mr. Hoster presented the unaudited Financial Performance summary and analysis reports for the 2016-17 fiscal year. He provided information summarizing a comparison of "budget to actual" revenue and expenditures for 2016-17, reviewing the Operating Funds. The district completed the fiscal year with an Operating Funds balance increase of \$1,677,067. He said the auditors will be completing their accounting adjustments this fall to establish the actual financial position for the fiscal year.
