Graduation Requirements

These courses will fulfill a requirement for graduation at Addison Trail High School.

Who should attend?

Summer school provides an opportunity for students to take courses required for graduation, accelerated courses that promote entry into an honors or Advanced Placement track, or enrichment courses that develop student skills.

Dates June 13-July 15

(Monday - Friday)

School will NOT be held on July 4

Dates/Times vary depending on course. A free breakfast will be served for a summer school students daily from 9:20-9:40.

Registration and Fees

Please fill out the center registration form in this brochure. **The fee for each course is \$160 (accelerated Geometry is \$320).** Payment and the registration form should be turned in to the financial secretary, Mrs. Cosio by April 15th.

Notification

A confirmation letter with detailed summer school information, including bus schedule, will be mailed in early June.

Credit

Students will receive credit and a grade at the completion of the course.

Transportation

Transportation to and from summer school is provided free of charge.

Location

Classes will be offered at Addison Trail High School. Please be aware that classes may be canceled due to low enrollment.

Introduction to Speech

This is a course designed to teach students the basic elements of the communication process, further their listening skills, and afford students the opportunity to perform several different types of speeches in front of an audience. This class will stress the research, organization, and nonverbal aspects of speech presentation. Students will also study group dynamics and have the opportunity to work in small groups to discuss current issues.

Online Consumer Education

This one-semester course focuses on specific consumer problems that students will encounter now and as an adult. This subject relates to everyday living and helps prepare individuals for making wise purchasing decisions. Topics include: budgeting, saving/checking, investments, comparison-shopping, using credit wisely, tax preparation, insurance, advertising practices, labor relations, and various consumer protection laws. **This course meets the consumer education graduation requirement. This SECTION is online - meeting physically for specific instruction and assessments; however, a majority of the work - including uploading assignments and student blogged responses - will be individual and kept on a calendar pace with the Instructor.**

Additional Courses

Accelerated Geometry

This intensive Geometry course will provide current freshmen enrolled in Algebra with an opportunity to reach upper -level courses in mathematics. A full year of Geometry will be completed during the summer, and students who successfully complete the course will be enrolled in Advanced Algebra & Trigonometry Honors in the fall.

Driver's Education

Both behind the wheel and classroom Driver's Education will be available to a limited number of students who turn 16 on or before September 30, 2016. In addition to the \$160 course fee, Behind the Wheel instruction is an additional fee.
