## MISCELLANEOUS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. Four tickets to the Commencement Ceremony will be distributed **after** the May 18<sup>th</sup> Senior Recognition Ceremony. Students will be required to sign that they have received their four tickets that day. Students needing additional tickets should collaborate with fellow classmates to locate and secure any additional available tickets. If students still need additional tickets (**2 ticket per family maximum**), they will be distributed in the Student Commons on **Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup> from 3:00-4:00 p.m.** Students are to bring a **signed note from their parents** indicating that the one or two additional tickets are for <u>immediate family members</u> only. **If there are any additional tickets remaining** after 4:00 p.m. on Thursday afternoon, you may come to the Student Commons through door #1 on **Thursday evening, May 18<sup>th</sup> between 6:00-7:00 p.m.** to see an administrator to get an additional ticket or two (depending on how many tickets remain after the 3:00-4:00 p.m. distribution).
- 2. Seniors have the option not to participate in the ceremony. Forms for this purpose are available in the Principal's Office and require a parent's signature. Diplomas will be available after May 21<sup>st</sup> at the school in the Registrar's office.
- 3. <u>Required</u> Commencement dress is formal or semi-formal attire: suit or dress slacks, dress shirt with tie, dress, skirt/blouse, pantsuits, dark socks and dress shoes. (No gym shoes)

Students will be sent back home to make adjustments if the required dress policy is not adhered to.

- 4. A professional photographer has been hired to take pictures of all seniors as they receive their diploma and you may order as many of these prints as you wish. Graduates providing an email address on their graduation ceremony reader card will have proofs emailed to them after the ceremony. A video of the Commencement Program will also be taken. DVD's will be available for purchase for \$25.00. Order forms are available in the main office and are included in this mailing. Also included in this mailing is the option to purchase flowers to celebrate this memorable occasion. We ask that people refrain from leaving their seats or blocking aisles and exits to take pictures. Videos and photos may be taken from your seat. Please do not stand or block someone's view when taking pictures. Please do not bring balloons or other items (i.e., airhorns, noisemakers, etc.) that will obstruct the view or disrupt and impact the experience of those individuals around you.
- 5. Caps should always be worn with mortarboards level and with tassels <u>on the right</u>. **Flowers** are not worn with caps and gowns. The ceremonies for which caps and gowns are worn are occasions of solemnity and dignity and consequently, merit suitable appearance and behavior.

NOTE: ALL BOOKS AND SUPPLIES MUST BE TURNED IN AND ALL FEES MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO ANY STUDENT GETTING THEIR DIPLOMA. All graduates must clear outstanding debts with the financial secretary, Ms. Muhlena prior to May 21<sup>st</sup>. Official transcripts will not be issued until debts and fees are paid. Only <u>cash</u> payments <u>or cashier's checks</u> will be accepted.
