Property/Casualty/Liability Insurance Renewal

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reported the district is a member of the Collective Liability Insurance Cooperative (CLIC), a self-funded insurance cooperative representing more than 178 school districts throughout Illinois. This year's annual premium reflects a 1.11-percent increase. Two factors directly impact the annual premium: 1) CLIC pool claim activity and 2) our high loss ratio of claim payout to premium paid. This is the second consecutive year with a favorable renewal. Future premium renewals should continue to be positive, as our recent year loss ratios are very low.

2018-19 School Calendar

Dr. Scott Helton, Superintendent, presented the proposed 2018-19 School Calendar. The calendar is similar to the 2017-18 school calendar, with 1<sup>st</sup>-semester exams before winter break. It will be presented for Board action on June 26, 2017.
