

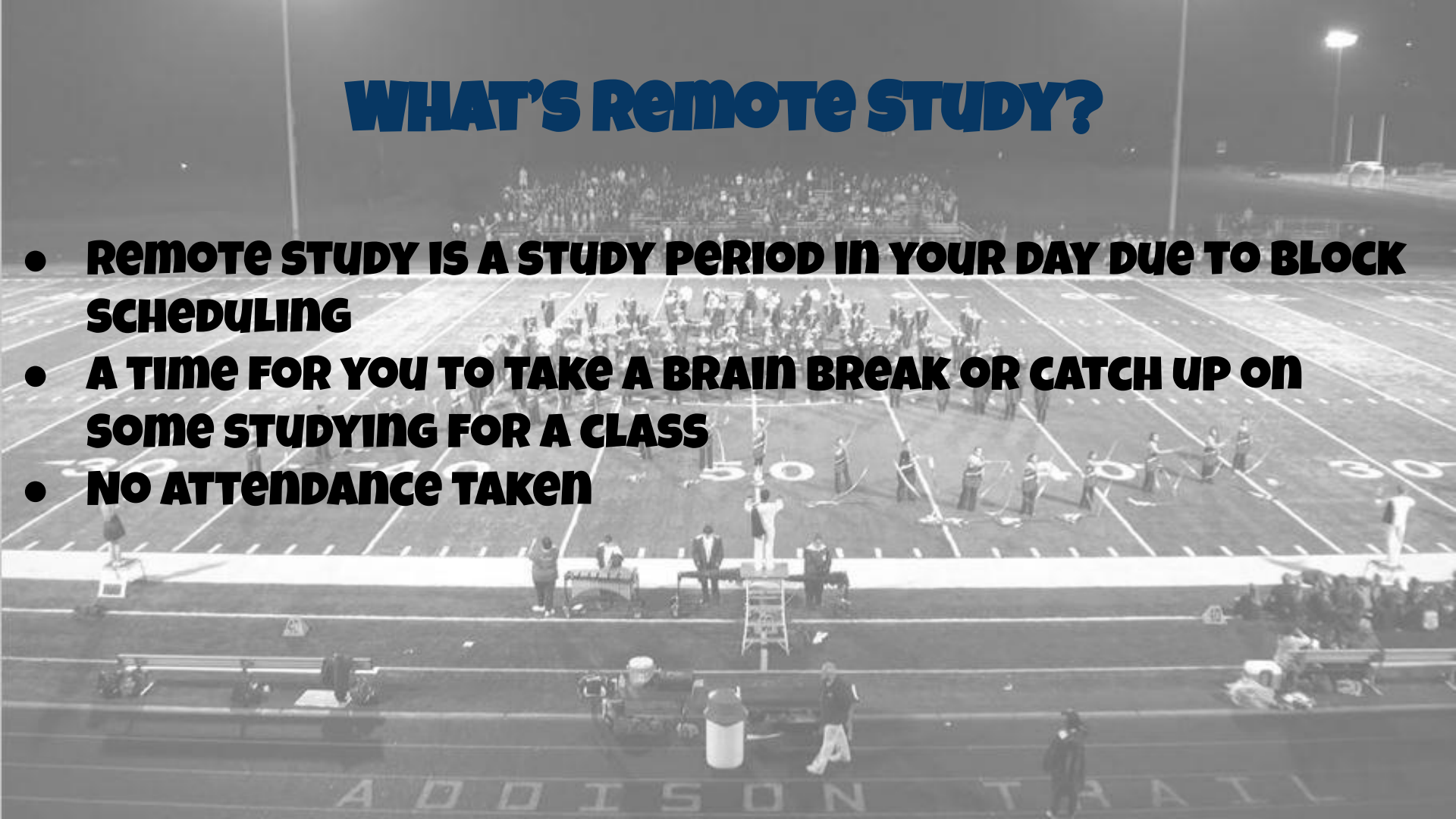

Be collaborative:

- Be willing to build new digital relationships with peers and teachers
- Be supportive and helpful to peers and teachers

GOOGLE MEET & ZOOM

Be accountable:

- Be on time
- Charge your Chromebook
- Recording of sessions is prohibited!

Be respectful:

- Log in with full name
- Turn camera on*

- Turn microphone off when not speaking
- Use chat with permission

Be engaged:

- Close other tabs
- Keep phone away
- Limit distractions
- Use gestures to participate

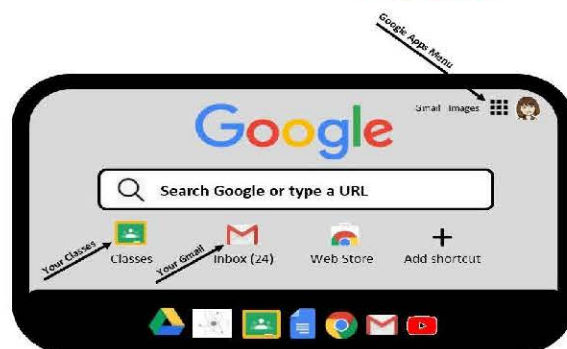

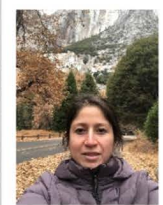

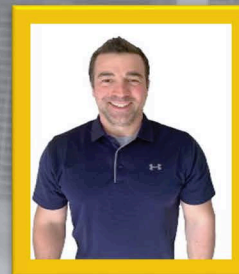
