

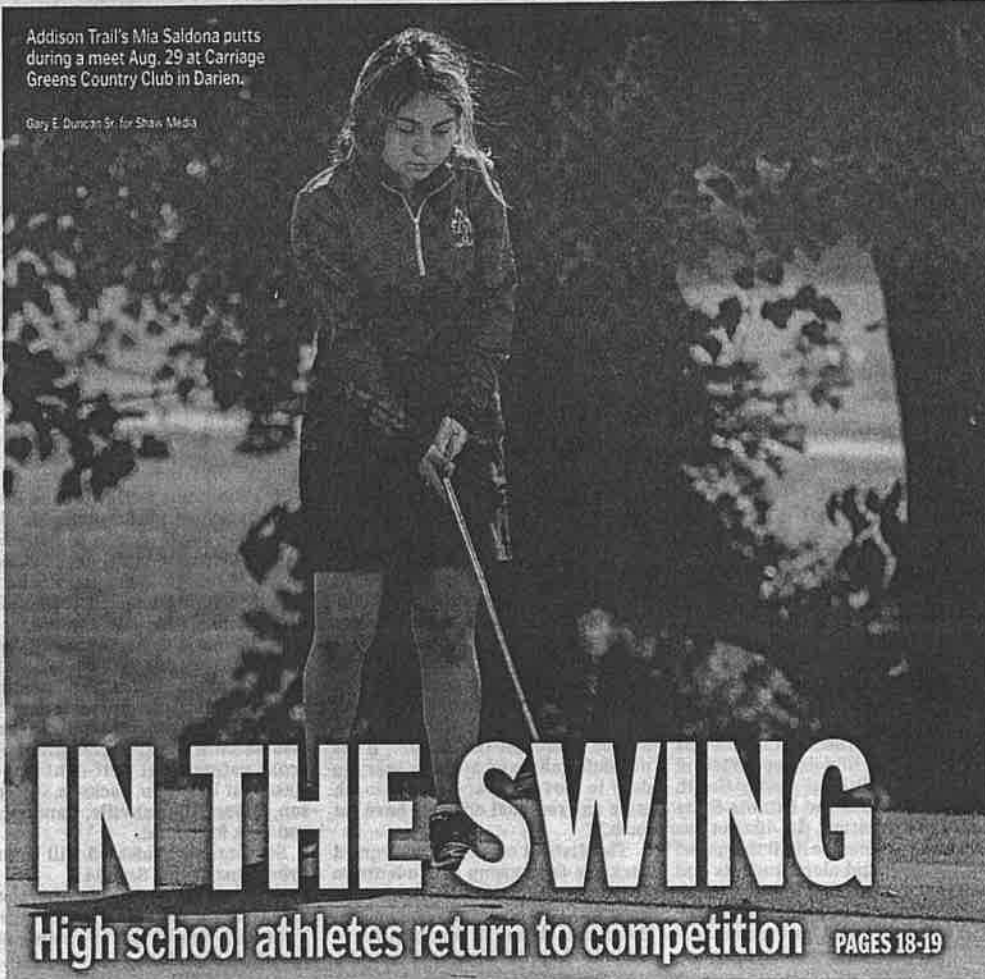

Several York staff members are exposed to COVID-19

ELMHURST – Several staff members in the multi-needs classrooms at York High School are following protocols for quarantine or self-isolation after COVID-19 exposure.

In-person instruction for those classrooms is delayed until at least Sept. 14.

Elmhurst Unit District 205 notified families and staff of the development in an email sent Sept. 1.

“With health and safety foremost in mind, the goal of the District 205 Leadership Team has been to return our students to in-person learning as soon as safely possible. Unfortunately, we have experienced a setback in our plans to bring our students in the multi-needs classrooms at York High School back on Wednesday, Sept. 2, as originally scheduled,” Superintendent David Moyer wrote.

Moyer said the staff and families in those classrooms have been informed, and the sanitation and disinfection of

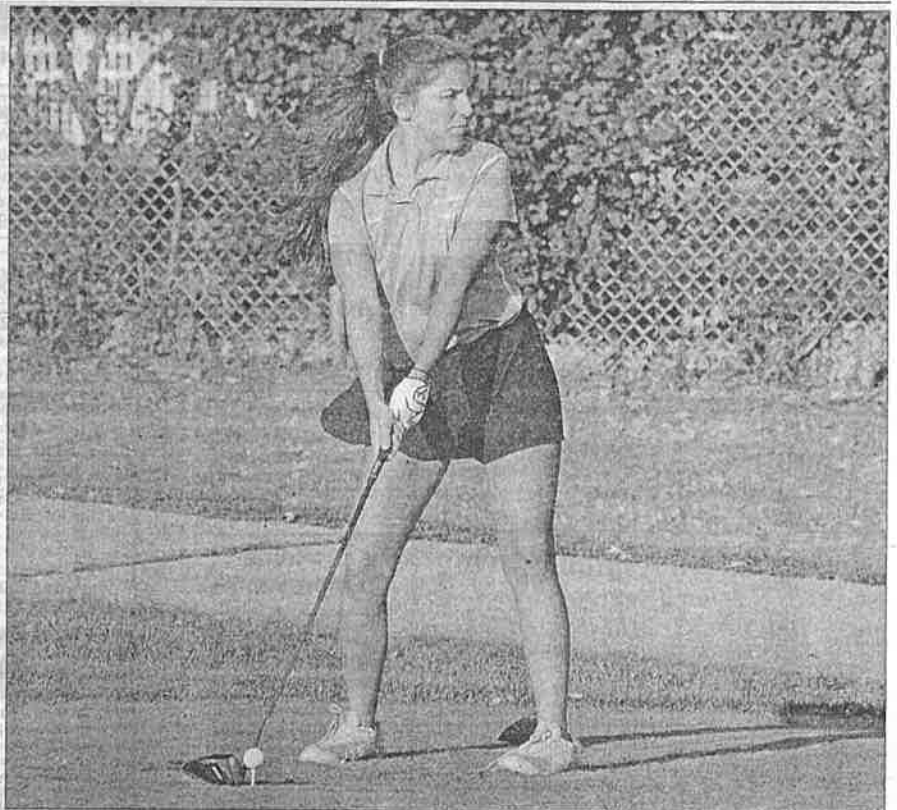

Warriors' girls golfers in action

Willowbrook's girls golf team completed a busy week with Saturday's competition against York and Glenbard West at Sugar Creek Golf Course in Villa Park. Playing at York's home venue, the Warriors earned a team score of 189. York won the team competition with its score of 165, while Glenbard West posted a 186. Junior Emma Rattana earned Willowbrook's best individual score by firing a 42 on the par-32, nine-hole layout. Sophomore Mickey Martens shot a 46 for the Warriors, while seniors Maddie Hayes and Peyton Mitrick turned in scores of 50 and 51, respectively. Willowbrook began the week with a West Suburban Conference dual meet against Hinsdale South. The Hornets (198) defeated the Warriors (203) in the team standings of the Aug. 24 meet at Village Greens of Woodridge. Rattana tied for first in the individual standings with her nine-hole score of 47. Mitrick contributed a 49, while sophomore Maddie Aderholt posted a 51. Hayes contributed to the Warriors' team score with a 56. On Aug. 26, Willowbrook played a conference dual meet against Glenbard West. The Hilltoppers (149) beat the Warriors (161) at Willowbrook's home venue—Twin Lakes Golf Club in Westmont. Rattana (top left) earned individual medalist honors with her nine-hole score of 33. Aderholt (above) shot a 42, while both Mitrick (far left) and Hayes (left) shot scores of 43. The Warriors' schedule this week includes conference dual meets against Downers Grove North and Hinsdale Central.
