SHARE INFO ABOUT YOUR CAREER/FIELD

Throughout the school year, we host career fairs and coordinate presentations with career professionals for students to learn about what's possible after high school. We invite you to participate and be part of these events!



HOST A WORKSITE VISIT/ FIELD TRIP

You can select a time/date for students to stop by and tour your facility. This is an opportunity to showcase your site and industry, while informing students about the career pathways and benefits available in your field.



HERITAGE SPANISH CAREER FLUENCY PROGRAM

Students would visit your facility once a week for about three months to shadow your employees. This course helps students develop their skills in professional settings and introduces them to a range of careers, while enhancing their biliteracy.



INTERNSHIP/APPRENTICESHIP

This is a tremendous way to build the future workforce. Students gain hands-on, real-world experience, and you receive help with achieving your company's goals. The schedule can be flexible, and we would set up all of the logistics.

- The internship/apprenticeship can take place during the school day, in the evening or even during summer break.
- Students can work daily or weekly – whatever best fits your needs.
- We will assist with the human resources/legal details and offer optional training to provide guidance for your employees who will work with the students.



SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT WITH JOB COACHES

District 88 provides vocational opportunities for students with special needs. This includes students in the District 88 Transition Program, which helps individuals ages 18 to 22 who have a variety of abilities learn life skills, obtain job training in a community setting and transition to life after District 88. The ultimate outcome is for the students to gain independence in the workplace. 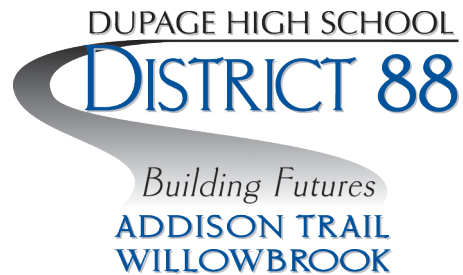
